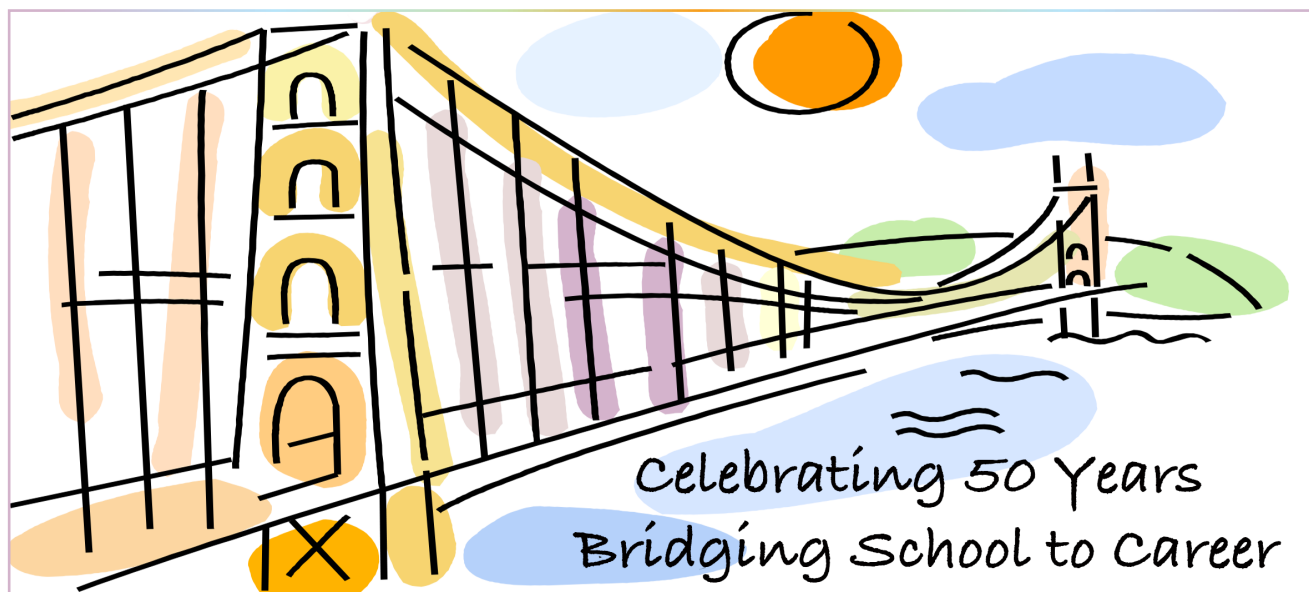

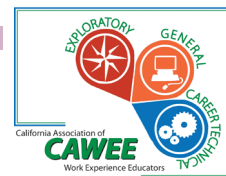

Super shuttle is one of the van pick ups from SFO and Oakland. The price ranges from \$40.- \$90.

BART: If you decide to take BART, the hotel will pick you up and drop you back off at the North Berkeley BART Station. Their complimentary shuttle runs throughout the day, making it easy for their guests to explore Berkeley, Oakland, San Francisco, and more.

Also a smaller van known as Wingz is a little cheaper. We suggest you do your own research for van and or car service. Uber is also available in this area, which is usually the least expensive.

Pre-Conference Sessions 9/30/15

8:30 - 10:30 am WEE Coordinator NEW & RENEW Workshop

This will be a detailed and valuable workshop for new and returning coordinators focusing on curriculum, class management, job site visitations, available resources and more. Time for Q & A will be provided, always an excellent opportunity to hear from other WEE coordinators.

10:45 am - 5:00 pm Work Permit Certification Workshop

This workshop option is intended for those who are certifying for the first time or are renewing their certification. Training will focus on child labor laws and essentials of approving work permits for minors.

Recommended for all individuals who supervise and/or approve work permits for minors in California. **The exam will be administered on Friday morning, October 2.**

With the certification, individuals who either issue, sign or generate the work permit for minors will have a complete working knowledge of the responsibilities, proper process, and purpose when issuing a work permit to a minor. This will help fill the demand for qualified and knowledgeable people who have the responsibility of issuing permits. At the same time, the Work Permit Certification helps satisfy an educational institution's need for a qualitative assessment of the employee's skills and knowledge, and better ensures the safety and health of our young working minors.

Work Permit Re-Certification

Those who wish to recertify and **have not** maintained their CAWEE membership during the three year period, and have not attended a minimum of two CAWEE Fall or Mini-Conferences, will be required to attend a Fall Conference and Pre-Conference workshop and retake the Certification exam for a fee of \$75.

To maintain certification without having to retake the test, you must do the following: a) maintain your CAWEE membership for three consecutive years; and b) attend a minimum of two CAWEE conferences within that three year period; and c) register and attend the work permit certification workshop on 9/30/15.

Conference Hotel

Our host hotel for this conference will be the Doubletree by Hilton, Berkeley Marina. Room rates are \$169 single or double, plus approximately 14% taxes, subject to change.

The cut-off date for these rates will be 9/8/15. Room reservations may not be available after that date, so be sure to get your reservations in early. Parking is free, guests will enjoy a delicious breakfast buffet, lunches included in the registration fee, and complimentary wireless internet.
